I am not sure you have checked lately or even want to know, but the US National Debt is almost 20 trillion dollars!! That's a staggering amount which many believe can never be repaid. However, here are some more statistics for American families and individuals that are also pretty overwhelming.

1- Average credit card debt among indebted households: \$15,263.

2- Average mortgage debt: \$147,591.


3- Average outstanding student loan balance: \$31,646.

to prepare them to be packed.


