Sealed with the Spirit! - Ephesians 1:13-14

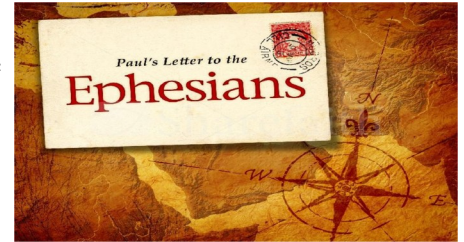

church envelopes or marking our checks for the GCF.

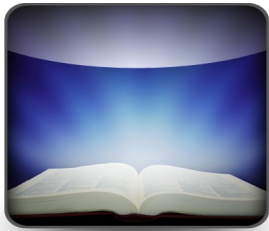

CPC Café, Decorations, & Communion Set-up

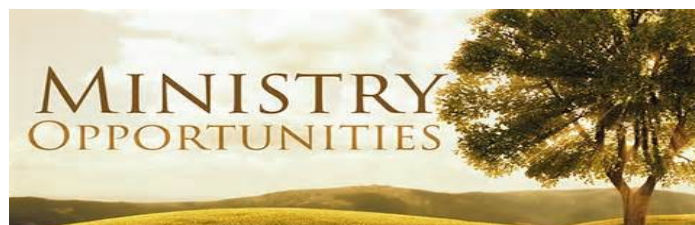

CPC Prayer & Praise

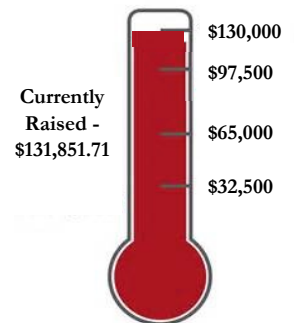
