The Son's Supremacy! - Heb. 1:1-4


Sadly, we live in a world where it's far too common to find men and women alike presenting themselves as though they're better than others! Even as believers in Christ Jesus, we can fall into the trap of being more self-focused than Christ focused. This can reveal itself in different ways and degrees, but the root cause is the same. It's when we're struggling with our worth and value being found in Christ alone. May God help us all.

One way God desires to set us free is by helping us to see



Christ Jesus for who He is and who we are in Him! This week at CPC, we'll be starting a new study through the book of Hebrews and it definitely highlights the supremacy of Christ.

As we begin our study through Hebrews, written most likely in A.D. 64-66, it's important to understand the author's intention even though he is unknown. His purpose was to present Christ Jesus, declared as the Son (Messianic title—Ps. 2), to be above all others! He didn't want his readers, who were Jewish Christians, to turn back to the emptiness of Judaism under the pressures of persecution! He wanted



them to press on to the end through unwavering faith in Jesus Christ.

The title of my message this week is "The Son's Supremacy" from Hebrews 1:1-4. My prayer is that our study through Hebrews will be life changing for everyone of us starting with me! Be assured we can never ask too much of the Lord, but we can ask too little.


CPC Greeters and Ushers
